10-Day Moose Float Hunt Gear List

In September our temperature ranges are usually 10 to 60 degrees. It usually rains half of the days.

Dry Bags: Everything should fit in these 3 dry bags—minus weapon

1 Large Dry Bag--Seal Line 115L Boundry Portage—for boots, sleeping bag, pad, and other large items

2 Medium Dry Bags—Seal Line 30L clear SEE—for clothes and small items

Clothing: (NO COTTON) everything synthetic or fleece--brown, green, or camo color.

Put your hunting clothes on in a quiet place-move around in them-if you can hear your clothes when you move; please get quieter clothes. We need to be able to hear moose calling back to us. Moose can be heard over a mile away grunting and raking back to our calls.

Socks, 4-6 pairs—Synthetic blend or smart wool

Underwear/Boxers, 2 pairs—synthetic

Base layers/thermals, 2 sets—all synthetic

Mid Layer, light weight & heavy weight, 1 set each—synthetic or fleece

Outer layer, 2 pants, 1 jacket—fleece waterproof (quiet)

Rain Gear

Helly Hansen Impertech Top—wear these before the hunt and break them in

Chest waders will be used for your waterproof bottoms

Clothing Accessories

Camp Shoes, Rubber over-calf boot or waterproof leather boot, Chest waders (no felt) or hip waders

Gloves-2 pair: 1 Lightweight, 1 Heavy weight

Hats: 1 each: brimmed & stocking hat, neck gaiter

Sleeping bag: synthetic, rated to 0 degrees—in waterproof compression sack

I have used the Big Agnes Farwell for years. The pad goes in the bag—you can't roll off the pad.

Sleeping Pad: closed cell Thermarest

MISC: Pocketknife, Binoculars, Hygeine Kit, Chapstick, Lens cleaning cloth, 5 gun cleaning wipes, 20 day supply of medicine, Headlamp and small flashlight, Book, Water bottle/Nalgene, Waterproof Camera, spare batteries, range finder

Rifle, synthetic stock, .30-06 or larger with quality scope—variable 3-9 power with 50mm bell

Bow, 50 lb draw minimum, 20-inch arrows minimum, 300 grain total arrow weight minimum

1 box (20rds) ammo/6 arrows

Walking/shooting stick—make sure it is not noisy when walking through woods.

Small day pack
